This week we are reading A Symphony of Whales. Please refer to the Family Times sheet for our language skills, vocabulary words, and spelling words for the week. We are also continuing to learn how to use guide words to locate words in dictionaries and in a glossary. Any extra practice with this skill at home would be very helpful. Even using alphabetical order skills by looking up names in a phone book will help the children become more proficient in using dictionaries.
