We will be having our first Quiz in Religion tomorrow. Your child should spend time this evening reviewing their notes and looking over Chapter 15 in their Religion Books. In Science we are learning about the three and four stage life cycles of insects and making observations. We are reading Boom Town, a story that is historical fiction. The vocabulary for the week includes: fetched, laundry, mending, coins, skillet, business, spell, boom, and pick. We will be practicing distinguishing between realism and fantasy, using context clues for word meaning and comprehension, and using complete sentences. We are also working on spelling words with short vowels. Our spelling list includes: happen, lettuce, basket, winter, sister, monster, supper, subject, lesson, spelling, napkin, collar, traffic, suggest, puppet. The spelling challenge words are: skillet, picnic, planet, system, and pumpkin. Each week I will be sending home the “Family Times” sheet that includes these spelling words, the vocabulary words and the skills for the week. Please keep this sheet in a handy place for you and your child to refer to throughout the week for studying.
