

TRINITY REOPENING PLAN SEPTEMBER 2021

Students, teachers, staff vaccinated and unvaccinated must wear masks. We will have a sufficient number of masks for students or staff who forgot their mask or need a replacement. Effective immediately any person over the age of 2 (including all students, personnel, teachers, administrators, contractors and visitors) must wear masks at all times in doors in P-12 school buildings, regardless of vaccination status. People with medical or developmental conditions that prevent them from wearing a mask may be exempted from mask requirements, as documented by a medical provider

- At least 3 feet of physical distance between students within classrooms is required. The distance of 6 feet is recommended between students and teachers/staff, and between teachers/staff who are not fully vaccinated.
- Large groups of students eating in the cafeteria will be based on community transmission rates. Trinity will maximize physical distancing as much as possible when students move through the cafeteria line and while eating. People do not need to wear masks when eating, drinking, singing or playing a wind instrument. When masks are removed for these purposes, individuals must be spaced 6 feet apart.
- Temperature screenings or screening questionnaires are no longer necessary.
- Hygiene is important. Handwashing and respiratory etiquette will be emphasized.
- Cleaning and disinfection of the facility will occur twice a day. This will involve sanitizing the handrails, doorknobs and bathrooms. If students are changing classes and therefore moving from room to room, the desks/chairs they vacate will be cleaned before a different group of students move into that space.
- We will inform parents/guardians that children should stay home when they are sick.
- Administrator will collaborate with the St. Lawrence county health department for guidance with contact tracing, quarantine regulations and specific guidance driven by the intensity of the Delta variant in our area.
