Registration Week begins March 4, and we look forward to welcoming new families from our community. We are asking our parents to tell your friends that registration for PreK3 through Grade 6 is beginning now. Share your positive TCS experiences with

friends! If you know of someone that is interested in our school and would like a tour, please have them contact the school and we'll be happy to schedule them. If they are ready to register, please have them check out our website, www.trinitycatholicschoool.net to learn about our online registration process. PLUS....If you DO tell another family and they enroll their child(ren) for the 2024-2025 school year, you will receive \$100 towards your tuition for that same year, if they mention your family.

On March 4th, you should receive an email with directions and the link for registration. If you have any trouble with this process, please call the school at 315-769-5911. All of the needed forms are in the FACTS parent portal. The bonus is you will only need to fill them out once, then they will be carried over to the next year. You will just need to update any changes. Once you start the process, it does autosave so if you can't finish it in one sitting, you can return to it later. You can re-enroll current students and register new students within the same account. *Remember FACTS Management has two pieces, the Family Portal for registration, and Payment Plans/Financial Aid. Your login information may or may not be the same for both, depending on how you set it up.

Current families will receive priority placement now through April 30th. As of May 1st, all spots will be open and students will be registered on a first come/first served basis.

They began as pilgrims traveled to Jerusalem & Later, they developed into the fourteen stations currently found in churches.

PALM SUNDAY

The last Sunday before Easter is Palm Sunday. The Mass recalls Jesus' arrival in Jerusalem in which palm branches & palm branches & cloaks covered the road.

FISH FRIDAYS

The tradition began as money saved by fasting from meat during Lent was given to the poor. Fish was a cheap protein replacement.

LENT

The word Lent actually traces it's meaning back to "Spring." The imagery is for the rebirth and renewal of our faith.


