ENROLLMENT

Attention families who have not completed their re-registration forms online for next year: If your registration forms are not completed, we can not guarantee your child will have a seat in their class for next year. -Select **Parent Log In** from the menu bar and **FACTS Family Portal** from the drop-down menu.

-Enter the District Code, which is **TRIN-NY**

-Type in your username and password. *(If you have forgotten your username, please contact the school. If you've forgotten your password, please click on the link provided.)*

-After logging in, click on **Apply/Enroll** in the left menu.

-Click on the **Enrollment/Reenrollment** link.

-Click **Enroll/Renroll** for current students

-Click on **Apply** to enroll a new student

The online process should take approximately 15 minutes to complete.

If you do not plan on reenrolling your child, please follow the above steps and click WILL NOT ENROLL next to your student's name.
